MEMORY VERSE In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth (**Genesis 1:1**)

HERE'S WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week we read Genesis 1-2 and learned how God made everything. Out of nothing God creates everything. He created everything in the heavens and the earth in six days. He did that so he could give us an example of how to live our lives: six days of work and then rest. God doesn't get tired but he knew that we would. He made the seventh day for us, we can rest and worship Him. Along with creation God, being three in one, said "Let us make man in our image." God created people: Adam and Eve, man and woman, a husband and a wife. They were put in the most beautiful garden, the garden of Eden. Their job, as God's image-bearers, was to show what God was like and to grow a family. That family eventually would also show what God looks like. God is very good. A very good God makes a very good world, with humans as his very good image bearers.
